1Please note the following general principles on inquiries concerning the collection and art-historical questions:

Please direct your inquiry to a single addressee.

Responses to inquiries that take more than 30 minutes to answer will be billed at €39/hour in accordance with the State Capital of Munich's schedule of charges and fees. Responses to inquiries that require scholarly expertise may take up to four weeks or more.

Please note that for security reasons, we will only respond to mails containing a complete signature including the sender's full name and postal address.

Legal restrictions bar us from examining and assessing works of art or writing up expert reports.

This includes advisory opinions on:

- attributions
- estimated values
- market prices

Please be aware that the Städtische Galerie im Lenbachhaus und Kunstbau, Munich, is a public institution and as such is subject to strict regulations concerning the issuance of expert assessments, in particular to the art trade and private individuals. We ask that you address such inquiries to a publicly appointed art experts (www.bv-kunstsachverstaendigen.de) or the art trade. We cannot refer you to specific experts.

Information on Franz Marc

The institution formerly competent to issue assessments concerning Franz Marc (1880–1916), the Kuratorium Werkverzeichnis Franz Marc, was disbanded on March 4, 2016. No new competent institution has been established; none of the former members of the Kuratorium offer expert reports or advisory opinions.

Information on Wassily Kandinsky

The Komitee Werkverzeichnis Wassily Kandinsky of the Société Kandinsky was disbanded in December 2014. No new institution competent to issue assessments concerning Wassily Kandinsky (1866–1944) has been established. None of the former members of the Société offer advisory opinions.
